Parents/Guardians will be responsible for coordinating transportation for their children if not within a close proximity to the school.



DUAL LANGUAGE IMMERSION IN FRANKLIN-MCKINLEY

Dual Language Immersion is a unique educational program offered in Franklin-McKinley School District (FMSD) that builds student bilingualism and biliteracy in English and in Spanish. The Dual Language Immersion Program integrates native English speaking and English language learning Spanish speaking students in the same classroom. The teacher provides academic instruction through two languages, one of which is the primary language of each group (Spanish and English).

PROGRAM GOALS

The goals of this K-6th program include:

- Bilingualism Students will develop high levels of language proficiency in Spanish and English
- Academic Achievement Students will perform at or above grade level in academic subjects aligned to state standards in both languages.
- Multiculturalism Students will develop a positive cultural identity and an appreciation other cultures as a 21st Century global citizen.

INSTRUCTIONAL MODEL

In Kindergarten, instruction is delivered in Spanish 90% of the day and in English 10% of the day. The amount of English language instruction increases as the students move up in grade level. By 4th grade, 50% of the day is taught in English and 50% in Spanish. Classes consist of 50% English speaking and 50% Spanish speaking students who serve as language models for each other.
